COVID-19 RESOURCES FOR PIKEVILLE RESIDENTS

How can you protect yourself and your family?

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Stay home as much as possible, especially if you are sick, unless you need medical care.
- Cover coughs and sneezes.
- Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily.

When will you get a check from the federal government?

- The Federal CARES Act approved immediate cash relief for Kentuckians.
- Eligible taxpayers will automatically receive an economic impact payment of up to \$1,200 for individuals or \$2,400 for married couples and up to \$500 for each qualifying child.
- Tax filers with adjusted gross income up to \$75,000 for individuals and up to \$150,000 for married couples filing joint returns will receive the full payment.
- Above those amounts is a sliding scale for the amount that will be received

- **Two weeks of paid sick leave at regular rate of pay** if employee is unable to work because he/she has been quarantined by government or health care provider order and/or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and seeking a medical diagnosis
- **Two weeks of paid sick leave at two-thirds regular rate of pay** if employee is unable to work because they must care for an individual subject to quarantine or must care for a child whose school or childcare provider is closed or unavailable for reasons related to COVID-19
- **Up to an additional 10 weeks** of paid leave at two-thirds regular rate of pay where an employee, who has been employed for at least 30 calendar days, is unable to work due to a need to care for a child whose school or child care provider is closed or unavailable for reasons related to COVID-19.
